Fitness required to become a lifeguard?

- Lagoon Lifeguard- 400m Pool Swim in less than 8 minutes (Minimum pool length is 25m).
- Ocean Lifeguard- 800m Pool swim in less than 14 minutes (Minimum pool length is 25m).
- 600m Swim, 800m Run, 600m Board Paddle, 800m run in less than 28 minutes on an ocean course.

Necessary Qualifications & Experience

- A current Working with Children Blue Card or ability to obtain one quickly
- Be at least 18 years of age Ocean Lifeguard
- Be at least 17 years of age Lagoon Lifeguard
- A current Queensland Driver's license
- Recreational Marine Licence and Personal Watercraft Licence – Highly Regarded

Successful applicants will need to have or obtain the below qualifications.

- Bronze Medallion (Certificate II in Public Safety – Aquatic Rescue) or industry equivalent
- Advanced Resuscitation Techniques Certificate
- Apply First Aid Certificate
- Other industry relevant qualifications provided as on going training and development during employment to successful applicants.

ALS will invite successful applicants to attend training to gain these above qualifications.
