- Ocean Mission (for ocean lifeguards only)
- Bronze Medallion (Certificate II Public Safety – Aquatic Rescue) or industry equivalent
- First Aid Certificate
- Advanced Resuscitation Techniques Certificate
- A current Working with Children Blue Card or ability to obtain one quickly
- A current Queensland Driver's License
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Recreational Marine License and Personal Watercraft License – Highly regarded
- Successful applicants will be invited to attend a mandatory fitness test and training will be provided to obtain all outstanding Surf Life Saving qualifications.
