Summary:	Grant Opportunity – Cancer Council QLD Portable Shade Project 2024-25 (Closing 23 February 2025)

The **Cancer Council Queensland (CCQ) Portable Shade Project 2024-25** is now open, **closing 23 February 2025**. This project provides not-for-profit organisations catering for children (0-18 years), including junior sporting clubs and community groups, the opportunity to apply for a free Portable Shade Marquee through their preferred supplier Integrated Branding Solutions Pty Ltd.

Please note the following key points:

- Organisations can apply for a fully funded 3x3m high-quality UVE95+% portable shade marquee
- Applicants may request more than 1 marquee, however there is no guarantee you will receive the full number of marquees requested
- Successful applicants will be provided with a marquee by CCQ through CCQ’s preferred supplier, Integrated Branding Solutions Pty Ltd (IBS), including delivery
- Choice of colour of the marquee is not permitted and the CCQ logo will be included on each marquee
- CCQ will not pay for additional branding or extra screen printing, however this can be arranged between the applicant and IBS at the organisation’s own cost
- Marquees will be delivered between 10 March and 12 May 2025 by IBS to the organisation’s address
- All marquees come with a 6-year structural warranty and 1-year fabric warranty
- Successful applicants will be required to participate in the post-Project survey to measure the impact the Project has had on improving sun safety activities in their organisation
- Mandatory attachments include: a copy of the clubs sun protection policy; letter of support from senior management, including endorsement of the sun protection policy; and evidence of not-for-profit status
- Successful applicants will be advised in March 2025 via email
