What is it all about?



What does being a Leader or Mentor Involve?

We don't want to overwhelm you with the responsibilities of a Leader or Mentor but here is an overview of what the program will entail for you. For a full role description please refer to the SLSQ Website.

- Ensure that participants abide by all the rules that have been set out for the program and provide a safe environment for participants.
- Encourage maximum participation and comradeship between the participants within your group.
- Ensure timely arrival of your group at each session as set out in the program and assist with the preparation and packing away of gear for all activities.
- Promote the ideals of Surf Life Saving Queensland and be a role model to all participants.

There may be some late nights and early mornings across the weekend to make sure everything is set up and ready to go for the day, but it will all be worth it when you see the growth and development in the participants. Leaders will be guided by a Mentor who has considerable leadership experience to mentor the leader through the experience of a SLSQ development program, so there will always be someone there as support.

Who can Apply:

Minimum requirements must be met. Candidates must:

- Be 18 years or over;
- Hold a valid Queensland Working with Children check/Blue Card/Exemption Notice;
- Be a current financial member of a Queensland affiliated Surf Life Saving Club;
- Show leadership qualities, and most importantly, a good rapport with youth
- Must be able to attend the entire camp (from 27th to 29th September 2025 + the additional leaders day on Friday 26th)

How much will it cost?

<u>Leaders and Mentors will be charged \$175.00 (GST exclusive)</u>. Please note that Leaders or Mentors who withdraw their application after they have been notified as successful and have accepted the position, will be invoiced for the full amount of the program. You must ensure you've spoken to your Club about your application prior to acceptance, as we do seek endorsement from Clubs and Branches before deciding upon an applicant.
