Summary: Two updates have recently been released to support compliance and strengthen the information captured through the Surf Risk Rating process
Date: 23 September 2026

The Surf Risk Rating is now live and available for use by all clubs and members. The tool provides a consistent way to assess and record surf-related risks, helping clubs make informed operational decisions and maintain clear records of the conditions identified at the time of each assessment.

Two updates have recently been released to support compliance and strengthen the information captured through the Surf Risk Rating process. The first enables users to upload photos while completing a risk rating, as shown below. These photos provide useful supporting evidence of the beach, weather and surf conditions at the time of the assessment, creating a more complete record and helping relevant personnel review the rating when required.

Confirm Control Measures
Confirm each mitigation is in place before finalising.

Confirm every control measure to enable acknowledgement.

The second update enables clubs to download a completed risk rating as a PDF and share it with club administrators, special events personnel or other relevant recipients. Once a rating is complete, open the list of completed ratings for that day and select **PDF**, as highlighted in the red box below. The PDF can then be attached to an email and sent to the required recipients.
