The Queensland Government Queensland Indigenous Youth Leadership Program 2024 is currently open. This program represents an excellent opportunity for leading Aboriginal peoples and Torres Strait Islander peoples to further their personal development.

The program invites participants to develop leadership skills and learn how to make change in their communities. Successful applicants will be invited to attend a seven-day leadership and career development workshop in Meanjin (Brisbane) delivered by community leaders, facilitators and mentors.

## The program provides:

- Leadership workshops facilitated by First Nations community leaders and content experts.
- Mentoring and networking opportunities participants can network with high-profile politicians, elders, community leaders, and representatives of the Queensland Government.
- Career development opportunities providing participants with links to employment opportunities, alumni development program, and access to ongoing mentoring and training.
- Post-program funding opportunities post-program grants
- Eric Deeral Indigenous Youth Parliament one-day event delivered by Queensland Parliamentary Services

Participants from remote, regional and urban communities across Queensland with a variety of employment and education backgrounds are strongly encouraged to apply.

## Key eligibility requirements:

- 18 to 25 years old
- identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander
- Currently residing in Queensland
- Not be a past participant on the program
- Available to participate in a workshop from 23rd to 29th November 2024
