
Eligibility and how your application will be assessed:

- The validity of lifesaving equipment requested.
- The current financial status of the Club / Branch.
- The Club is fully compliant with association Policies and Operating Procedures.

The final decision will be made by the QPS Lifesaving Development Fund Committee and is made up of representatives from both QPS and SLSQ.
