
This program is allocated funding each financial year to support community organisations to deliver projects primarily intended to benefit a particular divisional area and its residents, with each Councillor having a set total pool of funds to award within their Division. For this year's program each Councillor has \$40,997 to allocate.

Next Step – if your Club would like to submit a project you must <u>first consult with your respective Councillor</u> to advise them of the project you intend to apply for to both gauge their support for the project and to ascertain if they are accepting applications. Please then contact the SLSA GSU for assistance with the submission

Key points to note:

- Applications from \$250 to \$5,000 are welcomed
- All projects must contribute to the achievement of Council Plan Outcomes under the themes of Diverse
 Thriving Economy; Vibrant Lifestyle; Connected Community; Naturally Unique; Liveable Places; One City
- Projects will generally be of a non-ongoing nature and delivered within the financial year in which funding is provided
- Applications received under the project threshold will be determined within four weeks of submission
