The <u>Cancer Council Queensland (CCQ) SunSmart Shade Creation Initiative – Permanent Shade Grant</u> is currently open, <u>closing 22 November 2024</u>. <u>In this round, only organisations within the Townsville, Cairns and Hinterland Health Services Regions of Queensland are eligible to apply.</u>


This initiative provides not-for-profit organisations that cater to children aged 0-18 years the opportunity to apply for up to \$25,000 to purchase permanent, hard roof fixed shade structures.

Please note the following key points:

- In this round, only organisations within the within the Townsville, Cairns and Hinterland, and North
  West Hospital and Health Services (HHS) regions are eligible to apply. Full details on the catchment
  areas are available at <a href="https://www.health.qld.gov.au/maps">https://www.health.qld.gov.au/maps</a>
- Funding priority is given first to Townsville HHS, followed by Cairns and Hinterland HHS, and then North West, with applications reviewed and prioritised according to this hierarchy
- Organisations within these areas that received funding through the SunSmart Shade Creation Initiative in 2023 and 2022 are ineligible to apply this round
- Funding is only available to purchase new permanent, hard roof fixed shade structures
- Retractable awnings, temporary tents and umbrellas are ineligible under this opportunity
- Required attachments include 2 x itemised quotes; a copy of the clubs current sun protection policy, ABR certificate, Not for Profit certificate, diagram clearly showing where the structure will be located and letters of support from senior management (Club President)
- Successful applicants will be notified by 31 January 2025 with all projects to be completed by 30
   June 2025

The closing date for applications is 11:59 PM Friday 22 November 2024 (QLD time).
