2025 Queensland Cyclones Surf Boat Interstate Team – Team Management Expression of Interest

INTRODUCTION

Surf Life Saving Queensland is seeking nominations for Team Management positions to assist the 2025 Queensland Cyclones Surf Boat Interstate Team. The team will contest 2025 Australian Interstate Surf Boat Championships being held as part of the 2025 ASRL Open on Friday 14 February 2025, at Coffs Harbour, NSW.

The 2025 Queensland Cyclones Interstate Surf Boat Team will comprise of crews in the following divisions:

- Open Men
- Open Women
- Reserve Grade Men
- Reserve Grade Women
- Under 23 Men
- Under 23 Women
- Under 19 Men
- Under 19 Women

These crews will be selected at the QLD State Team Selection event on Sunday 26th January 2025 at Maroochydore.

After the close of nominations SLSQ may request endorsement from respective clubs of members who have nominated.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS (ALL POSITIONS)

To be eligible for consideration for Team Management positions in the Queensland Cyclones Surf Boat Team, all prospective nominees must:

- 1. Be a current financial member of an affiliated Surf Life Saving Club within Queensland.
- 2. Hold a valid and current QLD Working with Children Clearance (Blue Card);
- 3. Have completed all SLSQ Working with Children and Child Safe requirements including:
 - Child Youth Risk Management Strategy (CYRMS) Induction online course; and
 - o SLSA Child Safe Awareness online course.
- 4. Be in good standing with their club, branch and state.
- **5.** At all times abide by SLSA's Code of Conduct and act in a manner that does not bring the sport of surf lifesaving, SLSQ/SLSA or the Queensland Cyclones Representative Teams into disrepute.
- **6.** Be motivated and passionate about contributing to the success of the Team (including assisting with planning, logistics and communication in consultation with SLSQ Staff); and
- 7. Be available to attend any required competition briefings and/or meetings prior to and during the event.

DESIRABLE ATTRIBUTES / QUALIFICATIONS / EXPERIENCE

Desirable experience and attributes for Team Management positions includes but is not limited to:

- Previous experience managing representative teams at a Club, Branch, State, National and/or International Level.
- Comprehensive knowledge of surf boat competition and understanding of the Surf Sports Manual and rules particular to the surf boat competition and the interstate competition format.
- Previous touring / representative team experience.
- Hold a current First Aid qualification.





- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically.
- Have a sound understanding of sport integrity issues including anti-doping and competition manipulation.
 Note: All successful applicants will be required to complete the Sport Integrity Australia Anti-Doping
 Fundamentals Online Course within 7 days after being notified of their appointment (if not previously completed).
- Highly motivated and passionate about enhancing the success of the QLD Team and Athletes.

UNIFORM

SLSQ will provide each management team member with a team uniform which will be distributed prior to the competition.

SLSA CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

SLSQ and SLSA expects that all members involved in competition will co-operate to ensure a positive public image and to participate in a spirit of goodwill and sportsmanship. The SLSA Code of Behaviour, Competing Unfairly and Abuse/Inappropriate Behaviour clauses etc. are contained in the current edition of the Surf Sports Manual and any subsequent bulletins.

Any incidents or behaviour likely to cause embarrassment or damage to the reputation and/or image of surf lifesaving competition will be managed as prescribed in the current edition of SLSA's Rules, Surf Sports Manual and any subsequent bulletins.

ANTI-DOPING & MATCH FIXING

Surf Life Saving Australia supports the Australian Government, the Australian Sports Commission and Sport Integrity Australia (SIA) in their efforts to eradicate competition manipulation and doping in sport. Members have responsibilities under SLSA 5.02 Anti-Doping Policy, SLSA 5.11 Competition Manipulation and Gambling Policy and SLSA 6.23 Improper Use of Drugs and Medicine in Sport Policy (all available on the SLSA Members Area).

Please note that these policies apply for the duration of the 2024 Australian Interstate Championships. Please also be aware that random drug testing by SIA could take place during 2024 Australian Interstate Championships.

All team managers and coaches appointed will be required to complete the Sport Integrity Australia Anti-Doping Fundamentals online course (if not previously completed) within 7 days of notification of their appointment. It is strongly recommended to also complete the Sport Integrity Australia Competition Manipulation and Sports Betting Course (formerly Introduction to Match Fixing). Both of these courses are free of charge and provide an opportunity to develop a knowledge and understanding of anti-doping and match fixing in sport. It is recommended that all team members (including management and staff) download the Sport Integrity Australia app and utilise the GlobalDRO <u>Check Your Substances</u> site where required.
