Information	Surf Life Saving Australia has recently released an updated Water Safety Policy & Procedure.
	As part of the new release, the required water safety uniform has been updated to include shorts as part of the uniform. This inclusion must be adapted by all Clubs as part of the minimum uniform moving forward.
	Please note, the orange noddy cap is still required as per the current SLSQ High Visibility Clothing Policy (minimum uniform for water safety include – long sleeve high-vis orange rash shirt, shorts and a high-vis orange cap).
	In addition, SLSA have introduced a Nipper Safety Assistant (NSA) award. This award is designed to support U6-U8 in water activities, similar to the SLSQ Nipper Adult Assistant Induction (NAAI).
	SLSQ Clubs are permitted to continue to utilise NAAs for the duration of the 2024/2025 season. Further communications and support on the implementation of NSA's will be provided in the near future.
