Assessment Task Explanations

Course Introduction

The following procedure is for the provision of shallow water supervision for Surf Life Saving Queensland (SLSQ) club-based Nipper activities. These procedures have been developed using risk management principles and many years of experience with the provision of water and beach safety for aquatic activities.

Previously, parents were required to hold a Surf Rescue Certificate (SRC) or above to fulfil nipper water safety requirements as per SLSA Water Safety procedure 1.01.

The Nipper Adult Assistant (NAA) is to provide a non-fitness orientated position to allow members (parents) to contribute to the beach and aquatic supervision of our youngest nippers. Nipper Adult Assistants are qualified to provide water supervision or wading and 'shallow water' activities to the age appropriate depth. All NAA's must attend the Nipper Activities safety briefing conducted by the Water Safety Supervisor prior to the commencement of each weekend activity.

NAA's are not authorised to provide water supervision at any competition carnival.

Pre-requisites

To enter the SLSQ Nipper Adult Assistant Induction, Candidates must have met the following course prerequisites:

- Financial Member
- Minimum 18 Years date of assessment
- Hold valid Working with Children Blue Card
- Complete SLSQ CYRMS
- Complete SLSA CSA

Course Outcomes

By the end of this course, Nipper Adult Assistants will:

- Be able to operate safely and unassisted in a wading arena.
- Understand nipper activities operations and the club members to communicate with in regard to your role.
- Be familiar with wade techniques and wade competition rules.
- Be familiar with Beach Activities.

What clubs will need to complete this training:

 - Provide an overview of Junior Activities operations
 - Provide an overview of roles and responsibilities within Junior Activities including the role of NAA's
 - Provide an overview of wading activities for nippers
