

## **About Kal Glanznig**

Kal Glanznig, a Take 3 for the Sea Ambassador is one of Australia's leading youth ocean and climate champions. Creator of the documentary Rising Up, whilst in high-school he arranged a \$100,000, 100kW solar panel system, then supported over 20 schools to follow suit. In 2019 he co-founded Plastic Free Cronulla, building a community movement that has helped achieve a legislative ban of single-use plastics.

Kal was awarded Sutherland Shire Young Australian of the Year 2020 and Environmental Citizen of the Year 2023, he was part of the Youth Advisory Council for World Ocean Day and has been a speaker and delegate at the United Nations Climate Change COP the past 2 years. A passionate aquatic athlete, Kal has represented Australia in water polo at the Youth World Championships, he also did nippers back in Sydney. Kal co-created Blue Minds & the Youth Ocean Carnival, delivering major youth events to promote ocean action and ease eco-anxiety.
