Information	<p>Following the recent natural disasters in Queensland, the Queensland Government has now activated the <u>Sport and Recreation Disaster Recovery Program</u>.</p> <p>To be eligible for funding, a sport and recreation organisation must be <u>located in a Local Government Area (LGA) identified as disaster declared and activated for either “Personal Hardship Assistance” or “Reconstruction of Essential Public Assets” on the Queensland Government’s Disaster Management website.</u></p> <p>Please see at <u>Attachment A</u> the current list as at 18 March 2025 to identify:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. if your Club or Branch is in an eligible location, and 2. the closing date/s for applications for your area (noting that some Council areas have more than one activation open under this Program.) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where the organisation’s LGA is listed, funding will be available for application up to 3 months from the latest activation date. • Up to \$5,000 in funding may be available to reestablish facilities and activities including immediate clean up efforts. • Examples of expenses this may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ replacement of damaged equipment that directly relates to the re-establishment of activities (including office and canteen equipment). ○ payment of services and hire costs, and purchase of equipment and tools that assist in short term clean-up of facilities. ○ reimbursement for the purchase of the above made from the date of the relevant disaster. ○ funds for repairs and replacements when this amount is lower than the premium excess set by the insurance provider. ○ excess coverage for insurance claims. • Application to and/or receipt of funding under this program does not exclude applicants from applying for funding under other Qld Gov disaster grant programs for separate items/projects. • Full details on eligibility are available at https://www.qld.gov.au/recreation/sports/funding/disaster-recovery <p>If you would like the SLSA Grant Seeking Unit (GSU) to assist with the writing and submission of an application, or you have any queries in relation to this funding opportunity, please contact one of the following GSU team members.</p>
