## SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES PERMIT

*Transport Operations (Road Use Management - Accreditation and Other Provisions) Regulation 2015*

**Issued to:** Surf Life Saving Queensland  
**Authorised Persons:** Surf Life Saving Queensland staff and volunteers

**THIS PERMIT SHALL REMAIN IN FORCE FROM 8 DECEMBER 2022 TO 7 DECEMBER 2027 UNLESS SOONER SUSPENDED, SURRENDERED OR CANCELLED**

### EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to section 128 of the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management – Accreditation and Other Provisions) Regulation 2015*, and subject to the conditions and definitions stated in this permit, authorised persons are granted an exemption from the following provisions of the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management – Road Rules) Regulation 2009*:

- Section 270 – Wearing motorbike helmets
- Section 271A – Passengers in or on quad bikes or utility off-road vehicles

### CONDITIONS

1. When undertaking surf lifesaving functions in contravention of any of the exempted rules, authorised persons must:
  - a. Not operate the vehicle at a speed of more than 20 km/h.
  - b. Operate the vehicle within Surf Life Saving Queensland Standard Operating Procedure.
2. Vehicles must have factory fitted seatbelts and a rollover protection system.
3. A copy of this permit must be produced by authorised persons at the request of a police officer.
