SLSA Online Officials – SLSQ Requirements

SLSQ would like to provide some updated information for all Officials to assist with the logging of their attendance at Surf Sports events particularly Queensland events. We are aware that officials are utilising the new online system for logging of their Officials attendance instead of completing the Logbook, however we are seeing some differences in the manner in which some officials are logging information differently for the same event attendance. Most events are self-explanatory however we are seeing some differences in the below highlighted events.

Once Officials have logged into their members area and selected the option of "add Officials Attendance" they will then be able to add the required information.

Start Date and End Date – If the event is a multi-day event Officials are asked to place the first day of the event (start Date) and the last day of the event (end date) to ensure consistency across our Officials submissions.

Venue – This is the location that the actual event is being held.

Event Type – Below is a list of the Event Types that officials can choose from in the drop-down box. SLSQ Sport Committee has endorsed the classification of what a Major Event is as well as the classification of a Club / Local carnival in relation to the events conducted by Qld State / Branch and Clubs with examples of those events provided.
